

STEPS TO FOSTER OR ADOPT

FROM RAGofAZ



PLEASE NOTE: Adopters must be paid Active Members at the time a dog is delivered to them.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO ADOPT FROM RAGofAZ?

It depends on the age of the dog. When adopting a pair, the second dog is half price.

The adoption fee includes:

- health evaluation by a RAGofAZ veterinarian
- spay or neutering
- testing for valley fever and heartworm
- microchipping
- vaccinations (rabies and DHPP).

Additional treatment is considered on a case-by-case basis.

SINGLE DOG ADOPTION PRICE	
Age 0 to 3 years, 11 months	\$400
Age 4 to 7 years, 11 months	\$300
8+years	\$250

PAIRS - SECOND DOG HALF PRICE	
Both dogs younger than 3 years, 11 months	\$600
One dog younger than 3 years, 11 months and one between 4 and age 7 years, 11 months	\$550
One dog younger than 3 years, 11 months and one over 8 years	\$525
Both dogs between 4 and 7 years, 11 months	\$450
One dog between 4 and 7 years, 11 months and one over 8 years	\$425
Both dogs over 8 years	\$375

STEP 1

Complete the foster/FWITA application, located under the "Adoption Info" tab on our website at golden-retriever.org. Either submit it online, or print it out and fax/mail it in.

STEP 2

A local volunteer will contact you to schedule a home visit to discuss the process and gather specifics about the type of Golden you are interested in.

STEP 3

If approved, you will receive a welcome letter and Foster Manual via email.

STEP 4

When you are matched with a dog, a volunteer from the Placement Team will contact you with a full description of the Golden. We cannot guarantee that you will be matched within a particular time frame.

STEP 5

If you accept the dog, a volunteer from the Transport Team will bring the Golden to your home. You will be considered a FWITA (foster with intent to adopt). The adoption contract is signed at this point, and the adoption payment is collected.

STEP 6

Within the first 48 hours, you will be contacted by a member of the Follow Up team for an update on the dog, and also by a member of the Vet Care Team. Behavior, medical concerns, and other issues will be addressed.

STEP 7

After the dog has been medically cleared and you have evaluated the Golden's adjustment to your home for approximately 3 weeks, you will be able to finalize the adoption of the dog.

STEP 8

Enjoy the lifelong love from your rescued Golden Retriever.
